On Monday Year 4, accompanied by Mr Booth, Mrs Ormes, Mrs Jeacock and Mr Stallard, travelled to Beeston Outdoor Education Centre where they spent 3 days and 2 nights. The children took part in many activities including visiting Beeston Castle, exploring Peckforton Woods and going on a farm. A fantastic time was had by all. Thank you very much to the staff who went on the trip for both their time and care of the children.

Fr Paul writes, Firstly, I would like to thank you for your generous Cafod collection in support of their work in Africa. The collection amounted to £1053.68.

I ask your prayers for Anthony Hewitt who died on Tuesday. Please keep his mum and his family and friends in your prayers.

This week has flown by! The time of preparation of Lent is drawing toward its end. We will move to the 'Three Days of celebration of the Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection of the Lord.

On Palm Sunday at all Masses we will begin our Holy week with the blessing of palm branches. In the afternoon of Palm Sunday there is an opportunity for us to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation at 2.30pm. At this service we will also welcome our young people who are celebrating this Sacrament for the first time. On Holy Thursday we will celebrate the washing of feet as a sign of service to members of our parish community. We will then move on to the institution of the Eucharist in response to the Lord's command, 'Eat, Drink and do this in memory of me'. We will then move into 'the garden' and stay awake in prayer until the Lord's arrest. During this period of prayer, I will be offering the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This time of prayer will end at 10.30pm. On Good Friday from I I am until I 1.50pm I will be offering the Sacrament of Reconciliation. At 12.00 noon there will an opportunity to celebrate the Stations of the Cross. Some parents may like to bring their children to this as it will only last for 30min approx. Along with the children some of our older parishioners may like to join us too.

At 3pm we will celebrate the Lord's Passion. In the evening there will be a short time of prayer through music and silence at the tomb of the Lord. The Easter vigil will begin at 7,00am. This liturgy will begin in church as we listen to the Word of God through the ages. This will be followed by lighting our Easter fire and the lighting our Easter Candle, the proclamation the Lord has Risen! we will light our own candles from the Easter Candle, this will be followed by listing to the letter of St Paul to the Romans, the Solemn Alleluia and the proclamation of the Eater Gospel. After the homily we will renew our baptismal vows and receive the Risen Christ in the 'Breaking of the bread'.

Next weekend you will receive a leaflet with all the times of these Holy Week services.

Please be assured of my prayers and remembrance at Mass throughout the week.
