Parish Social & Community (PSC) Group: It was heartening to see more joining us for our second meeting last week. We had a full agenda and our main focus was on Christmas and also on the Universal Synod. We will be seeking help from parishioners for our Christmas decorating and should you be a former decorating team member, please do let Jayne in the parish office know, especially if you are willing to help this year. Due to continued COVID prevalence it is decided to postpose the parish Christmas meal this year. We hope that next year we can begin to organise larger social events.

More details from our meeting will be shared in due course especially with regard to various parish groups and activities. PSC group will meet on the first Wednesday every month with our next meeting being Wednesday 1 December at 7pm in the Parish Hall. Do come along - it's your opportunity to help shape our parish community: Firm in Faith, Joyful in Hope and Active in Charity. All are welcome.

Enrolment for the Sacramental Programme: The parents/guardians will present their children during the Family Mass. The enrolment form will be collected during the offertory and the children will be given a sacramental preparation badge to wear each time they come to the Mass.

A requiem Mass will be celebrated here at 12noon on Friday, 19th November, followed by the service at Blacon Crematorium Chapel at 1.20pm. Church will be open for prayer: During this month of November the church will remain open for prayer after morning Mass until 4pm. The Church has always taught that our charity should not be limited to the living. In Jesus Christ, we are given the power to help those who have died through prayer. The faith and love that bound us together in life still binds us in their new life and their prayers will support us in our journey of faith. You may light a votive candle once again but please remember to use hand sanitiser and wear a face covering as you enter the church to pray or to light a votive candle.

Remembrance List: During November, we especially hold holy the memory of all our dear ones who have been called to return to God. If there are any loved ones who have died that you would like to pray for, please use the special envelope in church to list the deceased members of your family. The names of your loved ones will rest at the foot of the Altar and they will be prayed for at each Mass.

Annual Bereavement Mass: This year's Mass will be on Sunday 21st November at 2.30pm. All are welcome to attend especially those who have been bereaved during this period of COVID. SVP are able to help anyone who may need a lift to attend.
