Sacramental Programme 2021-22: As announced last weekend the sacramental preparation for the First Holy Communion will begin on 17th October. SYNOD 2021-2023: This Sunday, the Holy Father will open Synod 2021-2023 in Rome. The following Sunday (17 October), the Diocesan Phase of the Synod will begin.
