Day for Life 2025: This Sunday, the third Sunday of June, Catholics across England, Wales, Scotland and Ireland will mark Day for Life which presents an opportunity for us to reflect and pray for the dignity of human life from conception to natural end. This year's theme "Hope Does Not Disappoint: Finding Meaning in Suffering" draws on St Pauls words in Romans 5:5-6, reminding us that Christian hope is not mere optimism, but an unshakeable trust in God's presence- even amid the darkest trials of illness, grief, or emotional pain. Archbishop John Sherrington, Bishops Kevin Doran and John Keenan have issued a message for the 2025 Day for Life, on behalf of the Catholic Bishops' Conferences of England & Wales, Ireland and Scotland. Statement on Assisted Dying Bill: Copies of Statement from the Catholic Bishops of England and Wales on the upcoming Third Reading of the Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill is available in the porches. Bishop Mark writes: "The statement is written by Archbishop John Sherrington and reiterates our opposition to the Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill in both principle and practice while highlighting the areas of grave concern relating to the impact of the proposed legislation on hospices and care homes; on health and social care workers; and the wholly inadequate 'safeguards' against the coercion of some of the most vulnerable all of which should be brought to the attention of Members of Parliament".
