The Gate Way to Holy Week: Next weekend we will be having a Penitential Service for us all on Sunday 25th March at 2.30pm. We will be joined by the families of our young people who are receiving this Sacrament for the first time. I promise that this service will not be very long.

Palm Sunday: At all our Masses next weekend we will receive a palm branch recalling Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. We will greet him as we would greet an earthly sovereign. #### GIFT AID SCHEME 2018/19:

New boxes for all using weekly envelopes are available for 2018/19 in the rear porch and are in alphabetical order.

The new yellow envelopes start on Saturday 7th/Sunday 8th April 2018 for the new tax year. Please do **not** use them before this date. If you are no longer paying income tax please let Mike Jevons know as soon as possible. We must adhere to the Inland Revenue rules for operating our Gift Aid Scheme.

If you a tax payer and donate cash each Sunday into the loose plate please consider joining the Gift Aid Scheme as we can claim 25p back from the Government for every £1 you donate at no cost to you! There is a minimum sum of £1,500 that we could potentially claim back each year. All you have to do is to sign one form declaring that you are a taxpayer and then decide whether to donate by a bank standing order (second form) or by weekly envelopes. The forms are available to download from the St Winefride's website or directly from Mike Jevons, Gift Aid Scheme Administrator (0151 336 5026).
