If you are a taxpayer the Diocese can reclaim tax for your parish on all your donations. Overall, for every **£1 you give your parish will receive additional 25p from HMRC**. Please use this method of giving if you are a taxpayer – it is such a help to our parish at no extra cost to you. Please do let the office know if you would like to give using the gift aid envelopes as we are about to order supplies for 2022/23. We are grateful that a number of parishioners have already started to pay by standing order instead of using the gift aid envelopes. Thanks for your continued generosity.
