

What does Fr Tom do?: *Fr Tom writes* - Thank you to so many members of the Parish and to our school who welcomed me so warmly last weekend. We are all aware that this is the first time in our Parish's 182-year history that the Parish Priest of St Winefride's has had other responsibilities beyond the Parish. Conscious of this, I want to share, over the next couple of weeks, a little information about the other roles I have in the Diocese. Next week, I will explain a little of what I do as Chancellor and, the week after that, I will write a little about the work of the Judicial Vicar. This week, I wanted to explain how I came to have these roles.

As many of you know, before Bishop Brian sent me to seminary to train to be a Priest, I worked for eight years as a commercial lawyer; first in the City in London, and then in Manchester. It was because I had this background that Bishop Mark asked me to do an extra degree in Rome to qualify as a Canon Lawyer, which I did in 2016. When I came back to the Diocese, we had six qualified and practicing Canon Lawyers. Sadly, since 2019, and particularly since the Covid pandemic, we have lost four of them to illness, retirement or departure for other reasons. For the two of us who are left, we are under pressure still to do the work previously shared by six of us. For this reason, I will need to give at least two days a week to this work – usually a Tuesday and Wednesday – and so Mondays and Thursday (plus the weekends) will be the days I am most available to the work of the Parish.

What does Fr Tom do?: Fr Tom writes – Thank you, once again, to all those who have been so kind in welcoming me to the Parish. I am writing to give everyone the chance to understand a little of what I do each week in my two other roles beyond the Parish. This week, I want to write about the role of the Chancellor, which is a role that supports the work of the Bishop. Every Bishop has three great Missions in his Diocese: The Bishop teaches through his Preaching and his oversight of Catholic Schools and catechesis; he sanctifies through his celebration of the Sacraments and through the celebrations of his Priests as his co-workers; and he governs the Diocese, exercising his authority to oversee and manage the running of the Church in our area. In carrying out these tasks, as a leader of a Community, a Bishop needs advice on the Law of the Church and on the procedures put in place so that, each according to our different vocations, we can all work well together in living and proclaiming the Gospel. This advice is the work of the Chancellor. Much of the work is confidential, but, day to day, dispensations and permissions for weddings, faculties for clergy, the incardination of Priests, Safeguarding, issues over the boundaries and property of Parishes or arising within the presbyterate; all these cross my desk. The Chancellor works closely with parish priests across the Diocese, with the Diocesan Curia, the Safeguarding Office and with the Bishop and his Vicars General.

What does Fr Tom do? Part 3: *Fr Tom writes* – thanks so much for all the kind interest that so many members of the Parish have shown in these little attempts to give everyone the chance to understand the work that I do at diocesan level. This week, I wanted to speak about the role of the Judicial Vicar. Every Bishop, in governing the Diocese he serves, has a court, or ‘Tribunal’, in which legal cases can be heard according to the Canon Law of the Church. In practice, the cases handled by the Diocesan Tribunal all relate to questions of nullity of marriage. Inevitably, these are deeply sensitive cases; they involve tragic situations and enormous personal difficulties and the parties and their witnesses are often very brave in trusting the Church with the details of these gruelling subjects. It is the Judicial Vicar’s job to receive those involved in such cases in such a way that, as Pope Francis said, they might know the Church ‘as a loving mother’. On the Bishop’s behalf (“vicariously”) the Judicial Vicar runs the Tribunal. This involves him in managing the Tribunal staff and volunteers and meeting with and interviewing the Parties and their witnesses and helping them to gather evidence. At the end of the process, the Judicial Vicar considers all the evidence and, applying the detailed law of the Church, sits as judge to make a decision, expressed in a carefully reasoned, written sentence. The role demands a combination of pastoral, administrative and legal skills applied in a way that is always sensitive to the fact that we must ask people to speak openly about deeply personal and often painful memories. It is some of the most challenging ‘professional’ work that I have ever been asked to do – and also some of the most important.
