Orphan Twins—New Ideas

Generally, supporting an overseas Twin is a years— 1 to 5 years— 1 to 5

We have 20 such Orphan Twin Conferences at the moment within our Central Council area and we are asking for support in the following ways:

A Conference or a District Council to take on an Orphan Twin at a cost of £150 per annum for a fixed number of years—1 to 5 years or more—you choose.

An individual to take on an Orphan Twin at a cost of £150 per annum for a fixed number of

Central Council is covering these costs at the moment, but If we are unable to find alternative financial support for these Conferences then at some point in the future we will have to send the Twins back to their National Council—something we are of course very reluctant to do.

Indian Student Sponsorships

State education in India is not always free, differs from State to State, and Government provides limited funds. We have 3 schemes.

For £15, the Vidya Jyothi Education Scheme (VJES) in covering the costs of books, stationery and uniform enables a child to remain in school for one year. Subsequent years are paid for by the local SVP or by a sponsor from another country.

Our **Technical & Vocational Training Scheme** (TVTS) supports a student on a training or diploma course in nursing, teaching, electrical engineering, plumbing, carpentry, computer science at a cost of £70 per year for up to 3 years.

The **Higher Education Scheme** (HES) provides support for future doctors, engineers, accountants and other professionals to undertake a university graduate course; this one calls for a commitment of £120 per year for up to 4 years and may be used to help pay for travel, living expenses or contribution towards academic fees.

In the context of the society we live in

here in Shrewsbury, these are modest sums and as you have seen from the report on the front page, Conferences are already supporting a number of students in one or more of the schemes.



Also, because sponsorship is not confined to Conferences we have a number of students being sponsored by individuals.

One of the advantages of sponsoring as an individual is that those who are taxpayers are able to Gift Aid their donation so that we can claim back the tax from HMRC

Whilst I know that this is a difficult time

for all of us, I urge you to think of how much more difficult it is for those we try to support in India.

Please encourage your Conferences, your parishes, your friends, and yourself to consider giving the gift of education through one or more of our schemes. I know how generous you have been over the past couple of years—I only have to look at the report on the front page—so I am confident that you will respond once again to our appeal.

I have attached a copy of the current print of the sponsorship application form to the email sending out this Newsletter so that you can download and print off as many copies as you need.

If, for any reason, you need hard copies of the actual form, let me know how many you need and I will post them to you.

Please return your completed forms to me, rather than to National Office, to enable me to manage our CC records.

Correspondence from Twinned Conferences (continued)

Dear Vintentian Brother Terry,

I am Claud Mendonca, the president of the Society of St. Vincent De Paul, St. Gonsalo Garcia Conference, Barampur, Vasai.

Our conference is twinned to St. Paul, Hyde.

My apologies, as I had not made contact with you for a long time.

.We are thankful to you for the financial help that you provide us thru the twinning.

We are about 11 Vincentian Brothers and Sisters who form the Conference.

We carry the following responsibilities

- 1. Meet on a regular basis.
- 2. Visit adopted families.
- 3. Provide Medical help to about 15 adopted families on a monthly basis by offering them Rs 1000 to Rs. 2000.
- 4. We also help patients with medical exigency cases where the family is unable to bear the entire burden on the medical expenses. We help them by giving a portion of the medical expenses up to about Rupees 50/60 thousand. For this the South Area Council of Vasai also helps us as we put forth the case to them.

If there are some specific questions that you would require me to answer, kinldy let me know and I would gladly help answering those for you.

I can also send you some of the photographs when we visit adopted families.

... We also pray for the eternal rest of David Williams and appreciate his dedicated services for the poor and the society. Kindly convey our deep condolences and prayers to his family. How is brother Dominic Ion? He suffered much for his illness. We wish to know about his health. Please convey our love and prayers to him.

Due to the adoption of strict measures at the earliest by the Central and State governments, the spreading is not so fast as Western countries. We are all in isolation and can buy food commodities nearby shops from 6AM to 1PM. We are in village area. But in corporations municipal areas weekly two days are allowed to get things. In few places the local bodies arrange door delivery.

Our cc has 93 conferences. 8 are in schools; others are in villages. As it is new Mission Diocese the parishes are mostly poor and newly converted. They have not enough faith as the hereditary faith people. The conferences have to work hard to promote them in economic development. Now at the affect of corona virus conferences supplied food items and cash to their adopted families. We are all in touch with the presidents of the conferences and give them proper directions. After the period of complete recovery of corona we have to motivate them to implement self help projects. So far we are all safe from the virus. Only 16 found and taking treatment. Few discharged from treatment. In India as today's report affected 21700, recovered 4325 and died 686.
